New Look for Sunday School

In keeping with the diocesan mandate to schedule Sunday School outside of the Liturgy time, our St. Nikola Sunday School will begin a new format for its school age children. All children, except the kindergarten age group, should be in church at 10 am for the start of the Divine Liturgy and remain there through the Holy Communion, at which time they will be dismissed to their 45-minute Sunday School classes. Kindergarteners will have their Sunday School class at the beginning of the Holy Liturgy and then go into church right before Holy Communion and partake of the Communion. (Children up to age 7 do not have to fast in order to receive the sacrament every week.) All children should be taking Communion every Sunday. (The guidelines for this will be discussed in their classes.) The schedule for Sunday School is as follows:

10 am: Divine Liturgy begins (all school age children should be in church)
10:15 am: Kndgn. Sunday School class begins (age 6 & under) in rectory
10:30 am: Gospel, followed by children's sermon
11:10 am: Kdgn. Students return to church
11:20 am: Holy Communion
11:25 am: Elem., middle-school & high school students dismissed for Sunday School.

Teen Group will have own session.

11:45 am: Coffee Hour begins
12:10 pm: Sunday School students dismissed to go to Coffee Hour

Registration for Sunday School will be on Sept. 6 & 13th, during Coffee Hour.

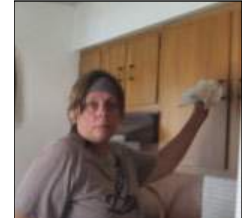
